## Frequently asked questions

~~What happens if I take a mobile phone or storage device into the exam?~~

Mobile phones/ipods/data storage devices (including watches) should not be taken into the exam room. If these devices are taken to the exam room they must be handed to an invigilator before the exam is started

If you are found to have such a device in your possession during the exam, the school has no choice but to report the incident to the Examination Board. The Examination board will determine the outcome.

~~Can I go to the toilet during the exam?~~

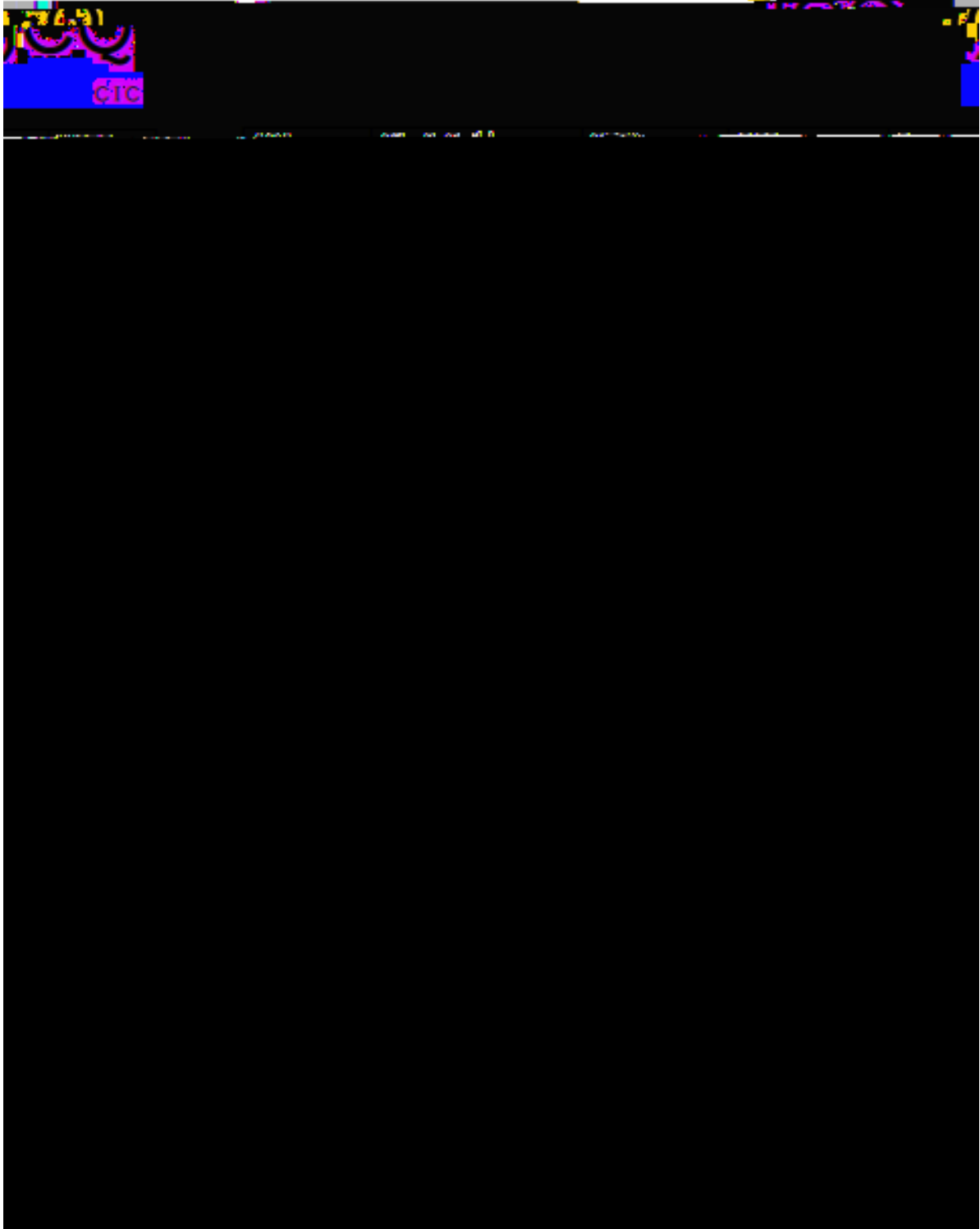

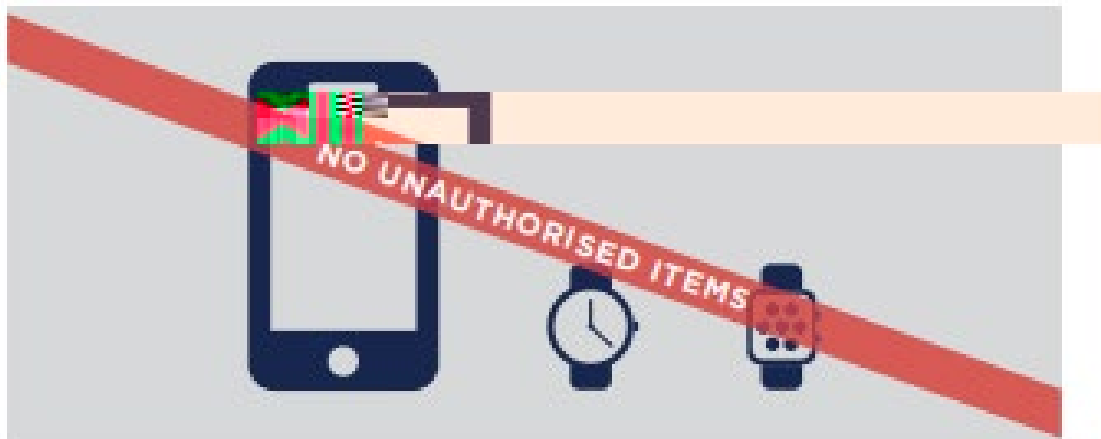
